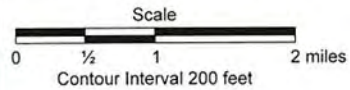
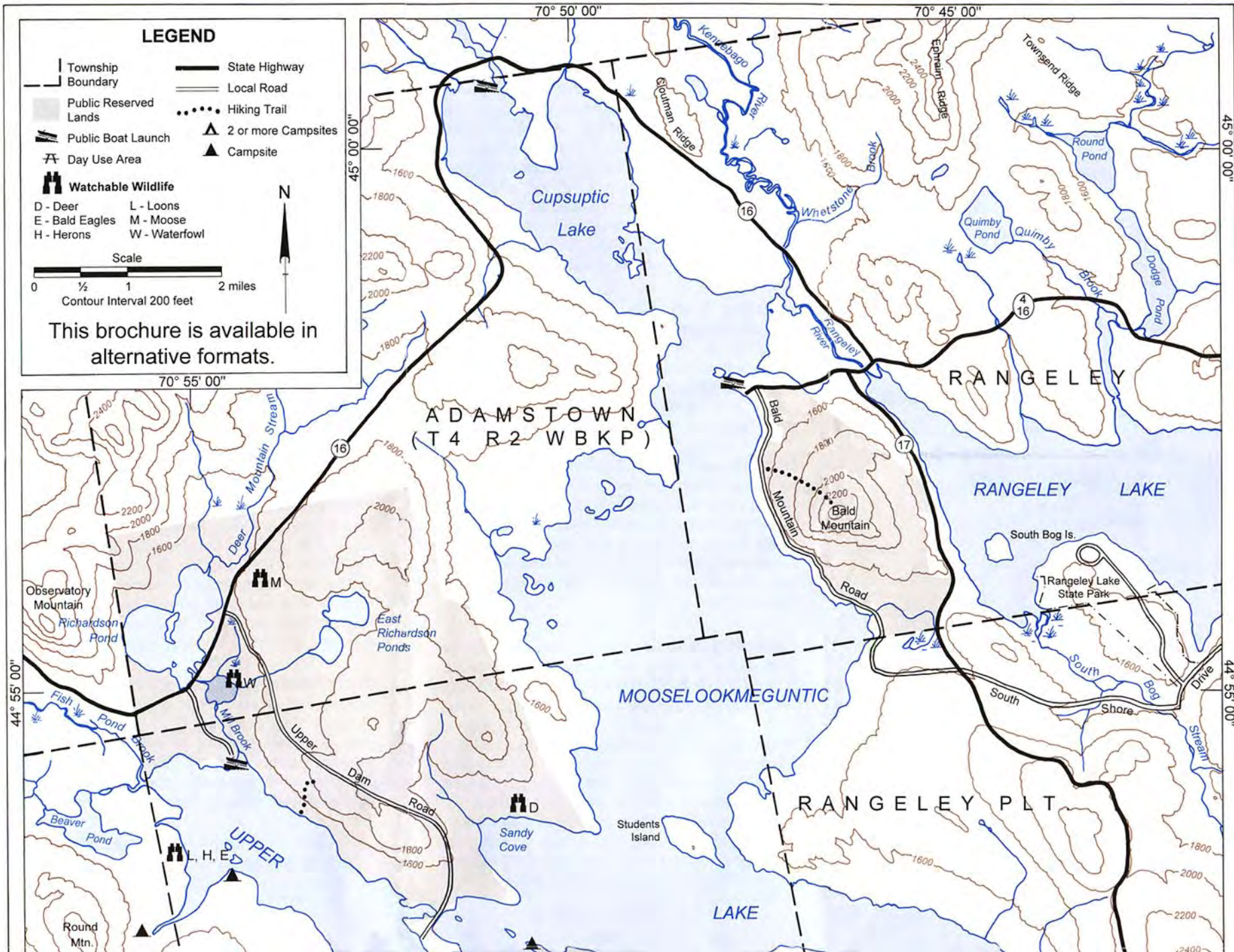


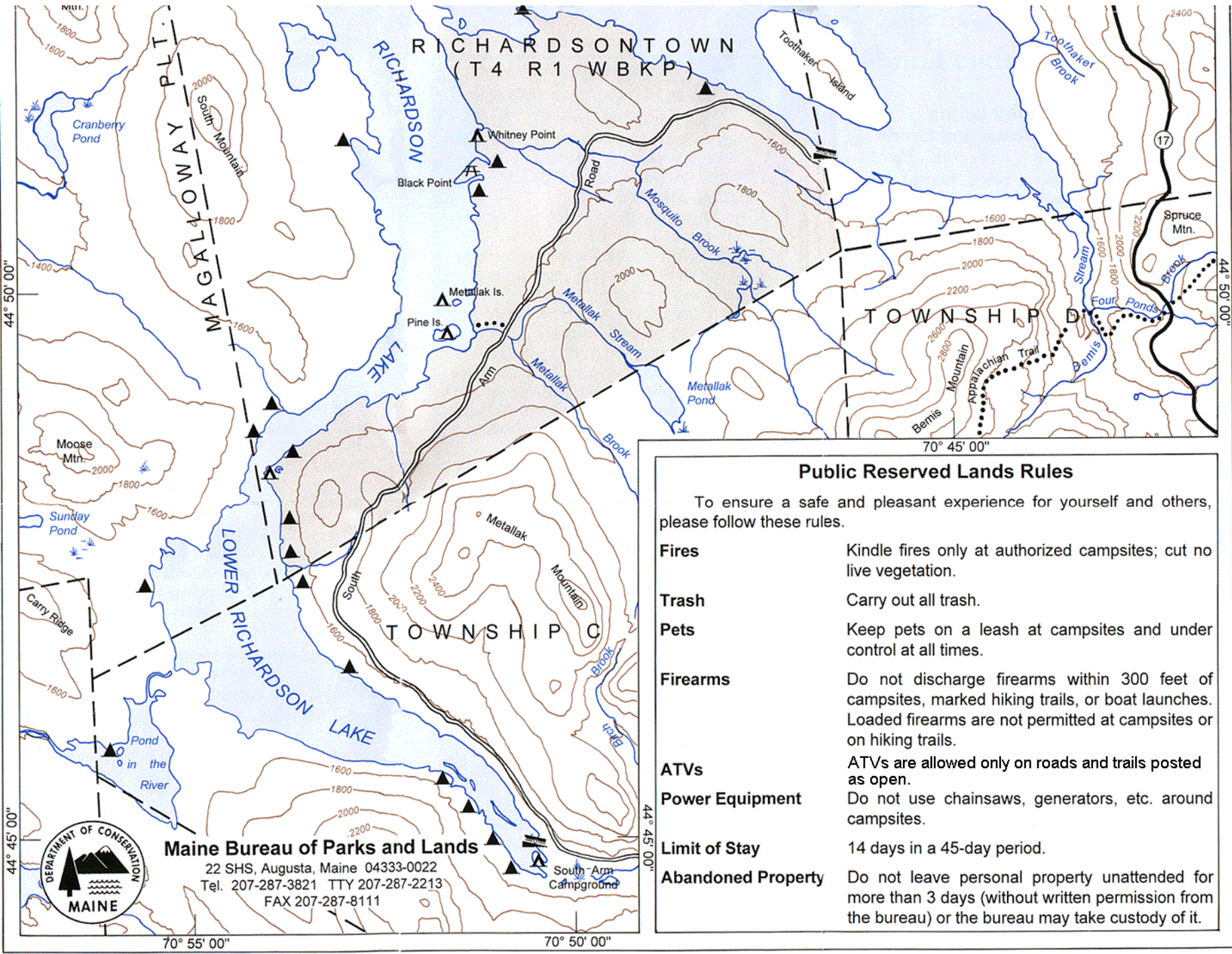

**Public Reserved Lands Rules**

To ensure a safe and pleasant experience for yourself and others, please follow these rules.

- Fires** Kindle fires only at authorized campsites; cut no live vegetation.
- Trash** Carry out all trash.
- Pets** Keep pets on a leash at campsites and under control at all times.
- Firearms** Do not discharge firearms within 300 feet of campsites, marked hiking trails, or boat launches. Loaded firearms are not permitted at campsites or on hiking trails.
- ATVs** ATVs are allowed only on roads and trails posted as open.
- Power Equipment** Do not use chainsaws, generators, etc. around campsites.
- Limit of Stay** 14 days in a 45-day period.
- Abandoned Property** Do not leave personal property unattended for more than 3 days (without written permission from the bureau) or the bureau may take custody of it.
