



Central Penjajawoc Preserve Trails



In 2010, Bangor Land Trust used funds from the Land for Maine's Future Program and the North American Wetlands Conservation Act to purchase two parcels off Essex St to create this 87-acre preserve. In 2013, funds from the Maine Natural Resources Conservation Program made it possible for us to purchase 94 adjoining acres, making a total of 182 acres of forest, fields, and marsh. You can enter this preserve from Essex St via a small parking area just below the level of the road 400 yards south of the intersection of Burleigh and Essex Streets. The narrow loop trails are open to foot traffic only (skis and snowshoes are okay too). The first loop trail opened in August 2013.
